**Directions from the Airport**

Take I-275 North. You will pass downtown. Continue north until Fowler Avenue (exit #51). Turn right (east) on Fowler Avenue. Turn left at Spectrum Blvd. Spectrum Blvd. is the traffic light following 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Directions from North**

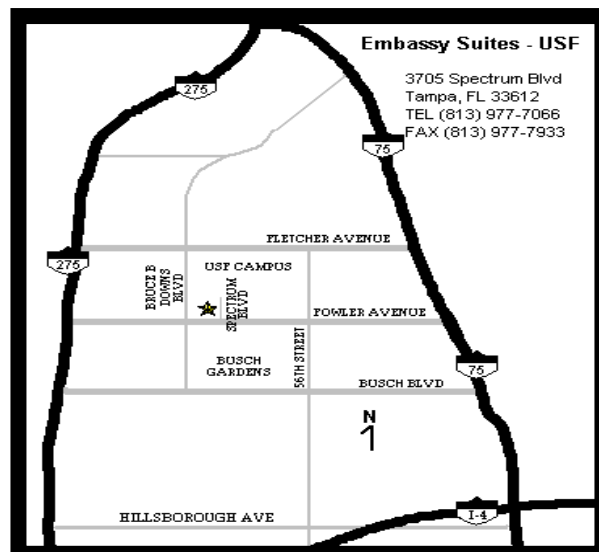
Take I-75 South. Exit Fowler Avenue (exit #265), turn right (west). Turn right on Spectrum Blvd. Spectrum Blvd. is the traffic light following the main entrance to the University of South Florida.

**Directions from South**

Take I-75 North. Exit Fowler Avenue (exit #265), turn left (west). Turn right on Spectrum Blvd. Spectrum Blvd. is the traffic light following the main entrance to the University of South Florida.

**Directions from East**

Take I-4 West to I-75 North (Exit 26). Travel 6 miles north to Fowler Avenue (exit #265). Turn left (west) on Fowler Avenue. Go 4.3 miles and take a right unto Spectrum Blvd.



# USF COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTIONS

## From I 275

- Take the Fletcher Exit and go East on Fletcher.
- When you pass McDonalds Restaurant get into the right lane.
- At the next major intersection which is Bruce B. Downs, turn right and swing immediately into the most left hand lane.
- Take the very first left hand turn possible (this is before the first traffic light).
- You are now driving toward the front door of the College of Public Health, however, go slow and see that the islands dividing the coming and going driveway lanes are split.

## From I 75

- Take Fletcher Exit and go West on Fletcher.
- When you see University Community Hospital on your right, get into the most left-hand turn lane as you will turn left onto Bruce B. Downs Blvd. which is the next major intersection.
- Take the very first left hand turn possible (this is before the first traffic light).
- You are now driving toward the front door of the College of Public Health, however, go slow and see that the islands dividing the coming and going lanes are split.



## PARKING

At the first split, turn left into a parking lot labeled “visitors” with a big, blue V. At the front of this lot is a parking permit machine that **only takes exact change of \$4** in bills or quarters. **Park only in this lot with your permit on the dash.**

**A limited number of parking passes will also be available at the registration desk.**
